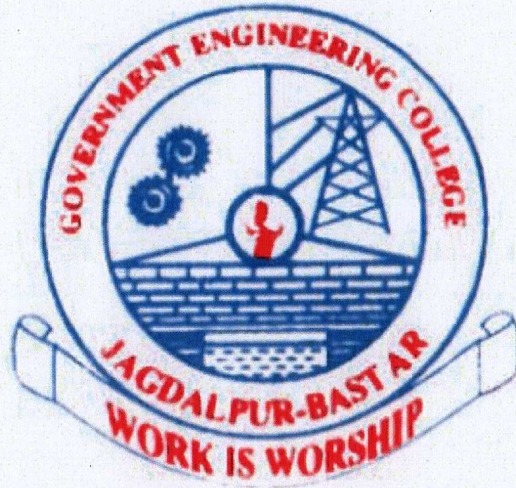

A short presentation on status of TEQIP-II Project implementation in the Institution as per approved IDP/RIDP and further approval of previous meetings was made by Dr. M.R Khan, TEQIP-II Coordinator before honorable members of BOG. There after the final agenda was kept for discussions and approval of honorable members.

After Sixth BOG meeting, various activities as per approved plan have been carried out on different heads of TEQIP-II project for the benefit of students and institution development.

1. Action Taken Report (ATR) on approved Plan by BOG Meeting held on 23rd December, 2017.

1.1 Procurement of software for Civil Engineering Department.

The STAADPRO has been procured and training has been completed from 1st March to 5th March 2017.

The SAP & MIDAS are deferred to be procured from TEQIP-III grants.

1.2 Procurement of software for Mechanical Engineering Department as Well as for Civil Engineering Department.

The ANSYS has been procured and training has been completed from 27th January to 31st January 2017 and from 14th February to 18th February 2017.

1.3 Procurement of Servers.

The specification has been finalized for servers keeping in view the Data/Application serving as well as the implementation of Security/Access policy.

1.4 Campus building maintenance & whitewashing and other miscellanies works.

Tender process has been completed and few work orders are issued, further work order are to be issued in near future.

1.5 New Building approaches pathway from main road.

Tender process has been completed and few work orders are issued, further work order are to be issued in near future.

1.6 ECA facilities in 6 Academic Buildings.

Tender process has been completed and work orders are to be issued in near future.

1.7 Minor modification in the constitution of TEQIP-II Committee.

Orders issued shall apply in TEQIP-III Project.

1.8 Establishment of D-Link Academy centre in the Institute.

The Discursion with D-Link is under progress likely to be implemented as soon as approved by D-Link.

3. Proposed Plan for approval

3.1 Proposal for the Glass Window paneling and other related works for E-enabled Classroom & Computer laboratory.

About 30 classrooms are now equipped with modern electronic AV smart facilities for online/offline E-teaching aids for the ambience of the classroom and to facilitate the necessary darkness it is proposed to fix-up glass window panel with tinted glass in about 40 rooms, and certain other floor related works, budgetary requirement is expected to be about Rs 20.00 lacs. The same has been put up for the approval of honorable BOG to be booked under development fund.

3.2 Proposal for Additional Sanction of Electrical Substation construction Transmission and Distribution within college premise.

In II BOG meeting dated 31st March 2015 agenda point no. 5.2, the idea of establishing a HT substation was carried out and allotted amount was Rs. 37.00 lacs including HT Transformer and LT overhead lines. For further establishment of connection to all departments of institute an additional amount of Rs. 90.00 lacs is estimated by PWD/CSPDCL. The work will be carried out by PWD/CSPDCL. The matter is put up to honorable members of BOG for their approval from Institutional Development Fund.

3.3 Proposal for Intuitional Development Plan for TEQIP-III.

The TEQIP project has been helping to strengthen the institution to improve the learning outcomes and employability of graduates of the Institute by the implementation of following measures:

- Modernization of Library
- Modernization of Class Rooms

The Coordinators, Nodal officers and members of different cells shall put in their sincere efforts under the able guidance and leadership of honorable chairman of BOG, head of the institution and honorable members of BOG and with the cooperation of NPIU and SPFU the Institute is confident to accomplish the above activities within the prescribed time frame.

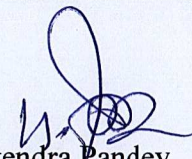

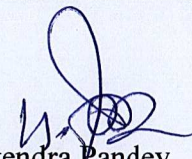

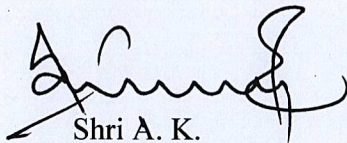

Agenda point no. 2 and 3.1 to 3.3 are approved as proposed.

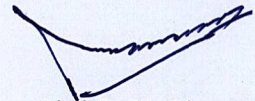
